Ensuring Children Enter School Ready

Who Qualifies for School Readiness?

- Children from birth to age 9
- Low to moderate income working families, those enrolled in school, OR a combination of both
- Those receiving cash assistance, as placed by referral
- Children in foster care, shelters, and those under protective services

School Readiness Child Care Financial Assistance allows eligible families to offset the expense of child care by paying a reduced parent fee.

School Readiness child care assistance is available to families who:

- Are at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level; AND
- Are employed at least 20 hours per week OR a student taking at least 12 credit hours.
