If you could not attend our Progress Monitoring Compliance Information Meeting, you don't have to worry. We have recorded the session to help provide clarity on Progress Monitoring requirements, offer solutions to issues, and provide ongoing resources to support VPK Providers' success with this program.

Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is a statewide, standardized program that all VPK programs must implement. The State is currently in the second year of this program, but the Coalition continues to receive questions from VPK Providers about various aspects of the program.

We discussed the timelines for Progress Monitoring windows 1, 2, and 3, who should be tested or not tested, and when, and how to use the data from the reports available to teachers to enhance their instructional practice. We also offered suggestions for testing strategies and how the timing of the testing may impact your annual Performance Metric designation, as well as offer VPK Providers additional information on resources, including support programs, coaching, and training
